We had a safe but long trip back to the USA which included a delay in Chicago. Once back in Tulsa, it took a few days to get over the jet lag, although we haven't stopped running since we arrived. Our days have been spent with various personal appointments and meetings with supporting churches, friends and individuals. We're overwhelmed at the response we're receiving. We have quite a few individuals who are interested in short term and possibly long term visits to The Fold. Two of them will arrive shortly after we return to South Africa.

The last week we were in South Africa, the extension of the fence around the playground was finished, so that the back door of the second house now opens into the playground. We had a special work crew finishing up the final touches. We also took pictures of the children outside the little hut where we will be selling a large selection of Harry's produce. Harry has really done an outstanding job with the garden.



A few days before we left South Africa we received a new child at the Fold. His name is Abram. We won't go into great details, but Abram needs a lot of care and love, and will hopefully have a great future. He is a very sweet boy and his English is very good. Abram is 15 years old.

We've had many groups offer fundraising events to go towards the purchase of a van for The Fold. Our friends in Wisconsin held a craft fair, raising \$400, and there was a dinner at Cedar Ridge last month raising \$1,400. Our St. Louis supporters organized a trivia night, which resulted in approximately \$5000 towards the van. At this point in time, we have raised about \$12,000, with approximately \$28,000 still needed. There are a few more smaller fundraisers scheduled for our remaining time in the states, which will also be used for the van. The money raised will be held in our South African bank account and draw interest at 4% until all the funds required have been raised.



Also for the van, we've started our 'Angel for Our Angels' program where we are offering an Angel wall hanging to any organization that believes that can generate at least \$300 in raffle ticket sales.
