This month Anna turned 17, Portia turned 6, and all the children at the Fold had a huge blowout party to celebrate the end of the school year and an early Christmas party. The party had to be held early, as every child left the property for most of December, to be with family members. This is the first time ever this has happened. They will all be returning a few days after our return to The Fold.
