Penny has just arrived back from maternity leave. She has a lot of work ahead of her getting some of our children ready to start school in only 5 weeks. The children were all happy to have her back.

We're going to have an awesome Christmas this year. There are already parties planned for the kids, also

some local lodges are going to assist with purchases for Christmas dinner. I'm getting excited about buying gifts for the children. All of us at The Fold wish all of you a very Merry Christmas.
