This is another area where we really need additional funding. Piet and Lucky who are 11 and 9, are in the 2nd and 1st grade. They were not taken to school in their earlier years. We're doing after school tutoring and need about \$500 additional funds per month to cover this cost as our volunteers cannot be with us on a daily basis.

We had more meat donated this month by some good friends. We had Mary and Carole visiting us when the meat arrived, so they were happy to help cut up some of the meat for a stew for the family. Our children really enjoy the stew.

We desperately need a new mower for the small jobs around the building and in the children's playground. We have gotten estimates of approximately \$600 for a mid range quality mower.
