It's been an amazing month. Lots of answered prayer. Some good friends sponsored our new lawn mower. We made a trip to Pretoria and found a good deal on a mower. Paul is very happy with some of the options on it. It has metal spokes on the wheels, as our previous mower was plastic and was falling apart. Along with an air vent that is located up along the push bar, instead of down on the mower. The dust here is horrific and choked the life out of our old mower. As soon as the rainy season starts, we are ready to cut the grass.

Another answered prayer was help with most of the electrical things in the second home. All the rooms now have a light fixture and an electric plug. Most of what is still needed is minor and won't affect the livability of the home. At this point, the only thing lacking is to remodel the old restaurant bathrooms, adding a bathtub to one, and a shower for the other, as well as running hot water into both bathrooms. Things are really moving along. We've received a lot of donations of furniture and clothing this month. The second children's home is completely furnished at this point, with just a few small things still lacking. We still need to raise an additional \$1500 per month in support before we can bring children into the second household. Please pray about becoming a supporter of our second household.

This month we also have Sonia and Becky spending a few weeks, half of October and most of November. They are 17 and 18, and this is the first time they've been on a plane, much less, out of the USA. They are a delight to have, and are working with the entertainment and more importantly with the education



of our children. The children have already fallen in love with them both. This is also their first missions trip. We are confident it won't be their last. Phil and June accompanied Sonia and Becky to South Africa on their way to another ministry work. Phil and June donated computers to the Fold, which the two girls are using



to train the children in computer use, and using computer programs to help the children with their reading and math skills.
