They spent a few days of the recent school holidays doing a vacation bible school with the children. They've taught the children how to throw a Frisbee and a lot of other fun activities. Their help next month while we are on furlough is a major blessing to the children's home. We wish we could have kept them another month.

We've had a lot of visitors this month. Ladies helping with tutoring and doing art projects with the children. Mick was able to get the slide installed on the jungle gym and the children are really enjoying it. We also hung an old tire from a tree, and that's become a favorite activity.



The plumbing for the second house has been started. We are hoping it will be finished soon.

The enclosed garden that we were blessed with is really coming along. At this point, we are not



purchasing very many vegetables, and those we are buying will soon be supplied by the garden as well and we will be self sufficient. The garden is really flourishing under Harry's care. So much so, that we have built a little road side stall and will be able to sell the excess vegetables.

It doesn't seem like it has been two years already, but it is time for our furlough again. We will be arriving at the Tulsa airport on 28 October at 8:12 pm on United flight 3670.
