We are currently in the USA on our fundraising trip and also visiting with family, including a new granddaughter we had never met. Things are going very well on this side. We have already had two successful fund raising events and will be in a different church every Sunday until we return to South Africa on 5 January. In South Africa, the du Plessis family has carried on with the house mother training every two weeks. They have been extra busy interviewing new house mothers for the opening of Dorothy house in January, and also searching for the children who will be living in that house. They have also interviewed and identified a teacher for our $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ grade children. We will be educating our youngest children on the Fold property beginning in January.



Our children did well in Prize giving this year. We are proud of them all. Next month will be very different at The Fold. For the first time ever, there will be no children at the Fold for about 4 weeks. They will all be returning to a relative's house. We return on 5 Jan and the children will all be back by the 7th in time to get ready for school the following week.



Back in South Africa, members of the South African Air Force came with presents, pizza and beds for the children. Looks like everyone had a good time. Plus the mothers got another morning of training, this time on the subject of discipline.
