They played with the children and worked on craft projects. We also had quite a few individual visitors throughout the month, each for a few hours, just to learn more about The Fold.

Jackie, a retired nurse and school psychologist, spent 2 ½ weeks with us. She is one of the team members from A World Aware, Inc., a group that consistently brings their members to help where our needs are. Jackie has been getting to know the house mothers, chatting with them about the discipline in the houses, and also spending time at the school with the children teaching them about their feelings and how to manage their anger.
