Son Safari was in South Africa for two weeks helping ministries and doing environmental work also. They blessed us with 9 people working for 5 days. Among many things they planted 1500 seedlings in the garden, moved rubble into the foundation of the chicken coop, played games with the children and taught them to crochet. Unfortunately this was the last month for the saturation team to visit us. They have been such a blessing for the children and help with our projects around the property. We'll get a new saturation team next year, and know we'll love them as much as our last two teams.



The Fold is officially full with 24 children now that Mapaseka (5 years) has joined us. Birthdays this month were Lettah (5), Gadibo (13) and Jessica (11). Dawid (4) and Megan (10) du Plessis also had their birthdays this month.



The chicken coop is slowly coming along, and once finished will help us save on food costs. The garden is expanding as well and also helps us save money.
