“Lebo was just 3 years old when he came to us earlier this year, he was withdrawn and spoke no English at all” - is what Lebo’s teacher shared with us. Lebo came to our children’s boarding school from a home dealing with extreme poverty. Due to a difficult home life and neglect, he was traumatized and behind in his development. But now, as he is experiencing love and security from our house moms and teachers, this handsome young boy is making incredible progress. Lebo’s story is one of many at our children's home. In South Africa, countless children feel hopeless. They live in extreme poverty, deal with horrific abuse, and have limited access to education.

All that we do wouldn't be possible without you. We will continue to grow only as we work together to meet the need.
